◆ What is Odori High School?

- Odori High School is located almost in the center of Sapporo City.

- Graduation requirements are to study at for three years or longer and acquire 74 credits or more. -

◆ What is the International Class?

- International students mean ones who are admitted to Odori High School through the additional entrance examination system for students who have recently come home from abroad. They belong to the Morning Class
- Get a homeroom teacher and a vice-homeroom teacher offering some advice on campus life.
- Study Japanese and Social Studies in the International Class.
- Belong to the general class with other Japanese students from the 2nd grade if Japanese has improved.
- Join the general class in Student-Led Activities(School event) and Period for Inquiry-Based Cross-Disciplinary Study, unless the content is too difficult to understand in Japanese.

◆ Admission Information for International Students

【Qualifications for Application】

1. Applicants should possess nationality of foreign countries and have lived in Japan for less than five years, or possess an equivalent of the above-mentioned qualifications which is recognized by the principal.
2. Applicants should have parents, either of whom is a repatriate from China, and have lived in Japan for less than five years since repatriation from China, or possess an equivalent of the above-mentioned qualifications which is recognized by the principal.
(A repatriate means the person who possesses Permanent residence return certificate.)
3. Applicants should possess nationality of Japan, lived abroad with parents or others for more than one year, and have lived in Japan for less than 3 years since return from abroad, or possess an equivalent of the above-mentioned qualifications which is recognized by the principal.
